**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF WASTEWATER ASSISTANT
SUPERINTENDENT AND ESTABLISHING THE JOB DESCRIPTION THEREOF AND
DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio has deemed it necessary to establish a new position of Wastewater Assistant Superintendent within the Village of Carrollton Wastewater Department and to establish the job description thereof requiring a Class II Waste Water License as required by the Ohio EPA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. The position of Wastewater Assistant Superintendent is hereby established in the Village of Carrollton, Ohio, which position shall be under the supervision of the Village Administrator of said Village and shall require a Class II Waste Water License.
2. The job description for said position is attached as Exhibit A and is incorporated herein as part of this Ordinance.
3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure continued operation of the wastewater department in compliance with the licensing requirements of the State of Ohio, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION RATES FOR VARIOUS FULL-TIME
AND PART-TIME EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, AND DECLARING
IT AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio deems it necessary to adjust compensation rates for full-time employees in the Street Department, Water Department, Wastewater Department and Clerical Department and the part-time police officer position in the Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. Compensation rates for full-time employees of the Street Department, Water Department, Wastewater Department and Clerical Department, and for part-time police officers in the Police Department of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio are hereby adjusted as follows:
