Village council met in regular session on the above date and time in the council chambers of the Municipal Building with President Pro-Tem Wilma Lambert presiding over the meeting.

Vote being 6-0, motion carried.

PLANNING COMMISSION REPORT: Tom Konst gave the report from the Planning Commission meeting that was held this evening at 6:30 o'clock P.M. Mr. & Mrs. Jim Long came before the board once again to try and get the zoning changed from B-1 to B-2 so they could purchase the property located at 12th Street and Daringer Avenue. This is now the second attempt to get this accomplished. They wanted to construct mini storage units on this property. After much discussion on this matter during the first meeting the board made the motion to deny the request made by the Long's on this matter. So now it is presented to council to once again to make the decision on it. White made a motion to approve the request for the Longs and Tangler seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Parker, no; Barto, no; White, yes; Lambert, no; Locke, no; Tangler, yes. Vote being 4-2, motion denied.

And spoke about the aggregation program and wanting to know how long it was for and that council needed to let them come to them with better rates. Tom Konst said council needed to update the zoning codes.

COUNCIL: Tangler ask about the Lincoln Avenue property and the raccoons and VA said he had sent the pictures that same evening to the Health Department. Tangler wanted to know how many kids were using the new sidewalk which Barto said when he goes to work in the morning's he does see kids walking on it. Police Chief said it was used Friday night for the football game.
