VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2025-28

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS FOR THE SCHOOL ZONE AND ROUTE 332 SIDEWALK PROJECT FOR THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio deems it necessary to establish a new school zone speed limit for the Route 332 school building complex and sidewalk project in the Village of Carrollton to address increased vehicle and pedestrian traffic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 4511.21, there is hereby established a twenty-five (25) miles per hour speed limit on South Lisbon Street (State Route 332) from Main Street South to the Village of Carrollton corporation limit, except that a twenty (20) miles per hour school zone speed limit is established during school recess periods and while children are going to or leaving school during the opening or closing hours of school, and/or when twenty (20) miles per hour school speed limit or flashing signs are erected and activated.
- 2. This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents and students of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to accommodate the increased traffic and pedestrian flow from the Route 332 school building complex and recently completed school sidewalk project within the time deadline of the start of the school year to ensure the safety of all students, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
