# A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION ORC 5705.19, ORC 5705.191, ORC 5705.25, ORC 5705.26, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY

The Council of the Village of Carrollton, Carroll County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2020 in the council chambers of the Municipal Building with the following members present:

Christopher Modranski, Brittany Tangler, Corey Yeager, Christopher Barto, Thomas Parker as
Wilma Lambert.
moved the adoption of the following Resolution:
<b>BE IT RESOLVED</b> by the Council of the Village of Carrollton, Carroll County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council determines and declares that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Carrollton, and that it is therefore necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of the Village of Carrollton, Carroll County, Ohio to replace the expiring levy for the benefit of the Village of Carrollton Fire Department for the purpose of fire protection [ORC 5705.19 (I)], at a rate not exceeding one (1.0) mill for each one dollar (\$1.00) of valuation, which amounts to ten cents (\$0.10) for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of valuation for five years being tax years 2021, 2022, 2023, 2024 and 2025, and which levy is a renewal of an existing tax of one (1.0) mill.

Section 2. The question of approving the renewal levy shall be submitted to the electors of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio at the general election to be held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November, 2020, and said levy shall be placed on the tax list of the current tax year, commencing in 2021, first due in calendar year 2022, in compliance with the provisions of ORC 5705.34, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

Section 3. The Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Carrollton is directed to certify immediately a copy of this resolution to the County Auditor of Carroll County, Ohio requesting that the County Auditor certify to the Village of Carrollton the total current tax valuation of the Village of Carrollton and the dollar amount of revenue that will be generated annually by the one (1.0) mill levy.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of Carrollton concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of Council and any of its committees that resulted in these formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with law.

Section 5. This Resolution is declared an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to meet the time deadlines established by the Ohio Revised Code for submission of a tax levy and to ensure the uninterrupted provision of fire protection, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
