VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2020-46

An Ordinance Approving the Expenditure of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) Funds, and Declaring It An Emergency

Whereas, the Village of Carrollton is a recipient of CARES Act funds to navigate the impact of the Covid-19 public health emergency;

Whereas, both the use and time of expenditure of CARES Act funds are restricted by the US Treasury Guidance and FAQ, the OBM Guidance and the US Treasury Office of Inspector General reporting and records retention requirements; and

Whereas, the Village of Carrollton desires to expend the CARES Act funds received in compliance with the guidelines provided for such funds.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio that:

- 1. The List of Expenditures of CARES Act Funds received by the Village of Carrollton is hereby approved, as set forth in Exhibit A attached.
- 2. Village Administrator, Mark Wells, and Clerk-Treasurer, Darla Tipton, are hereby authorized to execute the List of Expenditures of CARES Act Funds as set forth in Exhibit A and in compliance with the governmental guidelines and time deadlines for expenditure of the funds.
- 3. This Ordinance is deemed an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton to expedite approval of the expenditure of CARES Act Funds within the time deadlines of the governmental guidance of expenditure of the funds, and shall become effective of the earliest date allowed by law.
