**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE ODOT ROAD SALT  
CONTRACTS AWARDED IN 2021, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Carrollton, Carroll County, Ohio (hereinafter referred to as the “Political Subdivision”) hereby submits this written agreement to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation’s (ODOT)) annual road salt bid in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5513.01(B) and hereby agrees to all of the following terms and conditions in its participation of the ODOT road salt contract:

- a. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions established by ODOT in the road salt contract and acknowledges that upon award of the contract by the Director of ODOT it shall be bound by all such terms and conditions included in the contract; and
- b. The Political Subdivision hereby acknowledges that upon the Director of ODOT’s signing of the road salt contract, it shall effectively form a contract between the awarded salt supplier and the Political Subdivision; and
- c. The Political Subdivision agrees to be solely responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in ODOT road salt contract and agrees to hold the Department of Transportation harmless for any claims, actions, expenses or other damages arising out of the Political Subdivision’s participation in the road salt contract; and
- d. The Political Subdivision’s electronic order for Sodium Chloride (Road Salt) will be the amount the Political Subdivision agrees to purchase from its awarded salt supplier at the delivered bid price per ton awarded by the Director of ODOT; and
- e. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to purchase a minimum of 90% of its electronically submitted salt quantities from its awarded salt supplier during the contract’s effective period; and
- f. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to place orders with and directly pay the awarded salt supplier on a net 30 basis of all road salt it receives pursuant to ODOT salt contract; and
- g. The Politics Subdivision acknowledges that should it wish to rescind this participation agreement it will do so by written, emailed request by no later than Friday, April 24 by **12:00 p.m.** The written, emailed request to rescind this participation agreement must be received by the ODOT Office of Contract Sales, Purchasing Section email: [Contracts.Purchasing@dot.ohio.gov](mailto:Contracts.Purchasing@dot.ohio.gov) by the deadline. The Department, upon receipt, will respond that it has received the request and that it has effectively removed the Political Subdivision’s participation request. Furthermore, it is the sole responsibility of the Political Subdivision to ensure ODOT has received this participation agreement as well as the receipt of any request to rescind this participation agreement. The department shall not be held responsible or liable for failure to receive a Political Subdivision’s participation agreement and/or Political Subdivision’s request to rescind its participation agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the following authorized person(s) that this participation agreement for the ODOT road salt contract is hereby approved, funding has been authorized, and the Political Subdivision agrees to the above terms and conditions regarding participation in the ODOT salt contract.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, this resolution is declared an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to comply with the time deadlines of the Ohio Department of Transportation to participate in the annual winter road salt contract and to ensure an adequate supply of road salt for the Village at a reasonable price for the upcoming winter season, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2021-13

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
CARROLL COUNTY, OHIO TO PROVIDE ADMINISTRATIVE DISPATCH SERVICES TO  
THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio deems it necessary to enter into a contract with the Board of Commissioners of Carroll County, Ohio for the provision of administrative dispatch services to the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. The Contract Agreement between the Board of Commissioners of Carroll County, Ohio and the Village of Carrollton, Ohio for the provision of administrative dispatch services by the Carroll County Sheriff's Department to the Carrollton Police Department is hereby approved, as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.
2. William J. Stoneman, Mayor, and Mark Wells, Village Administrator, are hereby authorized to execute the Contract Agreement on behalf of the Village of Carrollton.
3. This Ordinance is deemed an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure the expedited approval of the Contract Agreement and the uninterrupted provision of administrative dispatch services to the Carrollton Police Department, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
