VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 2021-38

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ENTERING OF A LEASE FOR PARKING WITH AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio deems it necessary to renew the lease with American Electric Power to lease parking spaces for the Municipal Parking lot at the Ohio Power Carrollton Service Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

- 1. The lease with American Electric Power for parking spaces for the Municipal Parking Lot at the Ohio Power Carrollton Service Center for a term of five years commencing November 1, 2021 and ending October 31, 2026 in an amount not to exceed \$730.00 per year, as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto, is hereby approved.
- 2. Village Administrator, Mark Wells, is hereby authorized to execute the lease on behalf of the Village of Carrollton.
- 3. This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure adequate public parking spaces in the Village Municipal lot and to ensure expedited passage of the ordinance because of the termination of the existing lease, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
