WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through its Governor and Attorney General, and its Local Governments share a common desire to abate and alleviate the impacts of that misfeasance, nonfeasance and malfeasance throughout the State of Ohio; and

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND RELEASE WITH JASON NEIDERT REGARDING CANINE CARE COMPENSATION, AND DECLARING IT AN **EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Jason Neidert is a canine handler for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Carrollton and Jason Neidert deem it necessary to enter into a settlement agreement and release to resolve canine compensation issues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

- 1. The Settlement Agreement and Release with Jason Neidert, attached as Exhibit A, is hereby approved.
- 2. This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure the uninterrupted provision of canine services to the Carrollton Police Department and the public, and the avoidance of potential litigation, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
