AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF GOR-CON CONSTRUCTION, INC FOR THE
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT GARAGE ADDITION, AND DECLARING IT AN
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio deems it necessary to construct an addition to the Wastewater Treatment Plant Garage to provide storage area for Village equipment; and

WHEREAS, Council advertised for competitive bids for said project pursuant to the requirements of the Ohio Revised Code and deems it necessary to accept the bid of Gor-Con Construction, Inc., which bid met the minimum bid requirements and was the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. The bid of Gor-Con Construction, Inc. of Dover, Ohio in an amount not to exceed \$213,345.00 for the Wastewater Treatment Plant garage addition is hereby accepted.
2. Mark Wells, Village Administrator, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for said garage addition with the successful bidder.
3. This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure that the garage addition is completed in an expedited manner to prevent cost increases or construction delay because of continued supply chain disruptions, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A PAY INCREASE FOR CERTAIN SALAREID AND
NON-SALARIED POLICE OFFICERS OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Carrollton deems it necessary to increase the pay for the Police Chief, Sergeant and two of the police officers in the department to maintain a separation of pay rates to incentivize promotion in rank.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. Salaries or Per Hour Wage Rates for the following officers shall be increased as follows:

<u>Officer</u>	<u>Old Salary/Wage Rate</u>	<u>New Salary/Wage Rate</u>
Chief Tim Timberlake	\$58,115.20	\$64,355.20
Sergeant Geno Cook	\$51,875.20	\$58,115.20
Officer Paul Miller	\$23.77 per hour	\$25.77 per hour
Officer Mike Middleton	\$23.27 per hour	\$25.27 per hour

2. The salary or wage rate increases shall take effect with the pay period commencing April 10, 2022.
3. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

ORDINANCE 2022-12
