**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION RATES FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON SERVICE DEPARTMENTS**

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio deems it necessary to adjust compensation rates for employees in the Street Department, Water Department and Wastewater Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. Effective the beginning of the first pay period in January, 2023, compensation rates for employees of the Street Department, Water Department and Wastewater Department of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio are hereby adjusted as follows:

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION RATES FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING IT AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Carrollton, deems it necessary to adjust compensation rates for employees of the Village of Carrollton Police Department to be able to attract and retain officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. Effective retroactively to the beginning of the first pay period in November, 2022, compensation rates for employees of the Village of Carrollton Police Department, are hereby established as follows:

Full Time Officer (New Hire)*	24.00
Part Time Officer	16.00

*The new hire wage will be increased 50 cents per hour at the end of the six month probationary period and 50 cents per hour on the first anniversary date. Thereafter, the wage will be increased one dollar per hour the next two anniversary dates to \$27.00 per hour, subject to any Village-wide cost of living adjustment/raise and the Village longevity schedule.

2. This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure the continued ability to hire and retain sufficient officers for the Village police department to maintain fully staffed shifts for the safety and protection of Village citizens and property, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

Effective the beginning of the first pay period in January, 2023, the rates of pay for all full-time, non-elected, non-probationary employees of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio, except the Village Administrator, shall be increased by three percent (3%).
