CALL TO ORDER: Mayor William Stoneman called the meeting to order at 7:00 o'clock P.M. and those present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL: Everyone was present for tonight meeting.

- 1. Conducted Appalachian Grant sub-committee meeting on community trail and park improvements.
- 2. Attended Tuscarawas County Safety Meeting for BWC compliance.
- 3. Met with Aultcare representative in reference to the re-establishment of a local employee drug testing site.
- 4. Met with Wichert Insurance Corporate Officer and Clerk Tipton in reference to Village liability insurance review.
- 5. Met with Engineering Associates engineer and Service Department Supervisors to update Village Construction Standards.
- 6. Met with representatives from First Net/ATT Business solutions and Village safety officials in reference to the availability of Public Safety Network Cellular services in our area.
- 7. Request passage of ordinance for calendar year 2023 authorizing disposal of public property.
- 8. We were reminded by the Kimble Company that there will be a Government CPI (Consumers Price Index) rate increase of 6.5% for customers beginning in February as stated in our last contract renewal.
