ORDINANCE NO. 2023-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUB-SECTION 379.02(c) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE
VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO TO PERMIT GOLF CARTS TO CROSS DIRECTLY OVER
STATE HIGHWAYS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council recently approved Chapter 379 to the Codified Ordinances authorizing and regulating the operation of golf carts in the Village, prohibiting the operation of golf carts on State Highways within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Council deems it necessary to amend the Codified Ordinances to permit golf carts to cross directly over State Highways solely to access other roads upon which golf carts are permitted to operate within the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. Sub Section 379.02(c) of the Codified Ordinances as enacted by Ordinance No. 2023-24, passed on the 22nd day of May, 2023 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“379.02 DRIVING RESTRICTIONS...

(c) Golf carts are not permitted to operate on State Highways or roads that are posted over 25 miles per hour. Golf cars are permitted to cross directly over State Highways solely to gain access to roads upon which golf carts are permitted to operate.”

2. Existing Sub-Section 379.02(c) of the Codified Ordinances, enacted by Ordinance No. 2023-24 on the 22nd day of May, 2023, is hereby repealed.

3. This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure the expedited approval of the amendment to permit the uninterrupted safe operation of golf carts in the Village, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH ROY FORD TO SERVE AS THE INTERIM BACKUP SENIOR PLANT OPERATOR FOR THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ohio EPA regulations require that the Village of Carrollton have a Backup Senior Plant Operator for the Wastewater Treatment Plant with a minimum qualification of an EPA Class II Wastewater license; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Carrollton is currently attempting to hire a licensed Class II Wastewater Operator, but deems it necessary to retain Roy Ford as an Interim Backup Senior Operator in the event of the absence of the Wastewater Senior Operator to comply with EPA regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

1. The Agreement to retain Roy Ford as an Interim Backup Senior Operator for the Village of Carrollton Wastewater Treatment Plant is hereby approved, as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto, on an as needed basis in the event of the absence of the Wastewater Senior Plant Operator;
2. Mark Wells, Village Administrator, is authorized to execute the Agreement with Roy Ford on behalf of the Village of Carrollton.
3. This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton to ensure the expedited retention of an Interim Backup Senior Operator for the Wastewater Treatment Plant as required by the Ohio EPA regulations, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
