## **COUNCIL MINUTES**

JUNE 26, 2023

#### 7:00 O'CLOCK P.M.

Village council met in regular session on the above date and time in the council chambers of the Municipal Building with Mayor William Stoneman presiding over the meeting.

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor William Stoneman called the meeting to order at 7:00 o'clock P.M. and those present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL: Everyone was in attendance.

MINUTES: Tangler made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 12, 2023 meeting and Yeager seconded the motion. Roll call vote: Barto, yes; White, yes; Lambert, yes; Locke, yes; Tangler, yes; Yeager, yes. Vote being 6-0, motion carried.

## VA REPORT:

- 1. I have received the mineral rights agreement from Halo Land Management for 6.372 acres of unleased property and forwarded it to the Village Solicitor for review.
- 2. I attended the Appalachian Community Grant Program Kickoff meeting.
- 3. I received notice that the Village will receive a \$212,063 construction grant from the Ohio Department of Development Infrastructure Grant Program. This grant will be used to replace the failing PVC pipe with new iron ductile pipe in the water treatment plant.
- 4. The Village also will receive \$57,610 in grant funds from the same program for the lining of 3,403 linear feet of 8" sanitary line along Canton Rd. servicing business and residential areas to greater eliminate inflow and infiltration in the sanitary sewer lines.
- 5. The Rural Community Assistance Program has available grant funding and will perform additional smoke testing in the downtown area in the upcoming months. As a result of the last testing, that area did indicate problems requiring some further testing.
- 6. The 5th St "Splash Pad" is scheduled to being installation mid-July with a 3 to 4 week completion time.
