AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF KURITA AMERICA, INC FOR WATER TREATMENT PLANT FILTER REPACEMENT, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio has deemed it necessary to Replace the filter at the Water Treatment Plant;

WHEREAS, Council deems the filter replacement to be an emergency for public safety of the water users of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the replacement filter is the proprietary property of Kurita America, Inc. and cannot be competitively bid, thus making competitive bidding unnecessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

- 1. The bid of Kurita America, Inc. of St. Michael, Minnesota for Water Treatment Plant filter replacement in an amount not to exceed \$197,000.00 is hereby accepted.
- 2. The Village Administrator, Mark Wells, is authorized to enter into any contract or other document necessary for said filter replacement.
- 3. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure the filter replacement is completed in an expedited manner to ensure the public health and safety of water users of the Village of Carrollton and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
