#### Ordinance No. 2024-02

An Ordinance to make appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Carrollton, State of Ohio, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024.

Section 1. **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Carrollton, State of Ohio, that to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of Carrollton during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024 the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows, viz:

Section 9: **WHEREAS**, Section 5705.38 ORC requires that the Village adopt an appropriation measure prior to making any expenditures of funds for the fiscal year 2024; and

**NOW, THEREFORE,** this ordinance is declared to be an emergency necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare that such expenditures be made in order to provide for payroll and the acquisition of necessary supplies, equipment repairs and improvements as needed for 2024

And the Village Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village and for purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 8: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
