AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO TO SELL PERSONAL PROPERTY NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR USE BY INTERNET AUCTION PURSUANT TO ORC SECTION 721.15(D)

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio deems it necessary to authorize the sale of personal property which is not needed for public use, or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired, by internet auction pursuant to ORC Section 721.15(D).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

- 1. It is hereby authorized that during the 2024 calendar year, personal property, regardless of its value, including but not limited to motor vehicles acquired for use by municipal officers and departments or road machinery, equipment, tools or supplies, which is not needed for public use or is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired, may be sold by internet auction pursuant to ORC Section 721.15(D).
- 2. The auction shall be conducted by the Village of Carrollton using the internet auction site GovDeals and the property shall be open for bidding for not less than ten (10) days, including Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays, the terms of sale being for cash only with payment and pick-up/delivery due not more than thirty (30) days after the successful bid.
- 3. The Village of Carrollton, Ohio reserves the right to set minimum bid requirements for any individual item of property and reserves the right to reject all bids.
- 4. The Village of Carrollton shall publish notice of its intent to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit municipal personal property by internet auction in the Free Press Standard twice, with the second notice being published not less than ten days nor more than 20 days after the first notice of publication. The Village shall also publish notice of its intent to sell unneeded, obsolete or unfit municipal personal property on the Village of Carrollton website and on such additional internet sites as deemed reasonable for the type of property being sold to ensure that potential bidders receive actual knowledge of the intent to sell by internet auction.
- 5. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to publish a description of the specific property to be sold during the calendar year in compliance with the publication requirements above.
- 6. The Clerk-Treasurer is directed to post a copy of this ordinance continually throughout the calendar year in a conspicuous place in the Village Administration Building and on the Village of Carrollton website.
- 7. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

- 1. The Contract Agreement between the Board of Commissioners of Carroll County, Ohio and the Village of Carrollton, Ohio for the provision of administrative dispatch services by the Carroll County Sheriff's Department to the Carrollton Police Department for a three (3) year term commencing January 1, 2024 is hereby approved, as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.
- 2. William J. Stoneman, Mayor, and Mark Wells, Village Administrator, are hereby authorized to execute the Contract Agreement on behalf of the Village of Carrollton.
- 3. This Ordinance is deemed an emergency measure necessary to the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Carrollton, Ohio to ensure the expedited approval of the expired Contract Agreement and the uninterrupted provision of administrative dispatch services to the Carrollton Police Department, and shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Carrollton, Ohio deems it necessary to authorize cost of living adjustments to certain Village employees specified below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CARROLLTON, OHIO THAT:

- A cost of living adjustment of three percent (3%) is hereby approved for all full-time, non-elected, non-probationary employees, except the Village Administrator, and to the Fire Chief, Assistant Fire Chief and all firefighters, excluding the position of Secretary of the Village of Carrollton Fire Department, effective retroactively to the pay period commencing December 31, 2023.
- 2. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earlies date allowed by law, with the cost of living adjustment commencing for the pay period commencing December 31, 2023.
